High School Spanish classes have the criteria for Foreign Languages and underline the principle content of the Spanish curriculum. The course will instruct and enhances the fourth learning areas skills: Speaking, listening, reading, and writing. Besides the grammar content approach, this class is designed to promotes the Hispanic culture to understand the language deeper. Students will be able to communicate with people who speaks Spanish and become proficient language users.

NOTE: Every Spanish level lasts one school year divided into two semesters.

HIGHSCHOOL SPANISH I	<p>The Spanish I course is designed for students with little or no previous study on Spanish. The course introduces students to the basic language of the Spanish-speaking people. During the sessions, students will be able to use simple phrases to identify, understand and ask for situations, people, and places. The target language will be used mainly to satisfy immediate communication needs. Students can introduce themselves and others, ask for and give basic personal information. HIGH SCHOOL SPANISH II	<p>This course will reinforce the Spanish language skills taught on Spanish I. Students will have a review of the key concepts and lexical items and create continued practice and drills throughout this course. They also will be exposed to past, future, and conditional tenses, and they will be expected to apply them in their writing assignments as well as their speaking.
